

	Molecules Move slow but keep their form

4. Now, use the slider on the bottom of the program to Add Heat. Notice the thermometer at the top of the program. What temperature scale is this thermometer showing? 342° K

5. What happens to the water as you increase the temperature? As temperature increases the molecules separate & move about the area.

6. What is the melting/freezing point of water in Kelvin? 273.15° K

7. Add heat until the temperature is just below and then just above the melting point of water.
